



Product and Warranty Information

Your Act+Fast Children's Anti Choking Trainer should include:

1. The patented Act+Fast Children's vest
2. An internal Air Bladder
3. Clear Plastic Airway. (This should fit snugly into the coupler on the Air Bladder).
4. Three packages of Foam Plugs-1 green, 2 yellow
5. One attachable Back Slap Pad
6. User Manual, please refer to for detailed instructions.
7. Choking Prevention and First Aid for School Age Children Instructional Guide
8. Nylon drawstring Carry bag

Tips for using the Children's Anti Choking Trainer:

- Foam Plugs: To customize the level of ease for your student's needs, the foam plugs can be rolled in your fingertips to soften, or trimmed to shorten. Either method will allow the foam plug to be expelled more easily if needed.
- Make sure students cinch both the shoulder straps and waist straps so the Trainer fits properly.
- Make sure to load the airway with a single foam plug.
- Always be present for training and remind students that correct technique Does Not require force.
- It is important not to be forceful, as you could injure the person you are trying to save.

Limited Warranty

Act Fast warrants to the Customer that the Equipment (constituting the Children's Anti Choking Trainer) will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service for a period of (1) year from the date of shipment.
